

## Doug Moore

Started in racing in 1970 at the age of 12 riding exhibition races at the NW Washington county fairs. Began his professional career in 1975 at the age of 17 after graduating from Republic High School. Rode primarily in the Washington, Oregon, and Idaho. Also rode at Centennial Racetrack in Colorado and Finger Lakes in New York. In 1989, after ending the Playfair meet as leading rider, accepted the position of assistant racing secretary and clerk of scales at Portland Meadows.

1989 to 1994 worked as a racing official in Washington, Oregon, Montana, and Minnesota performing the duties of assistant racing secretary, paddock judge, clerk of scales, assistant steward, and steward.

In 1994 began working for the Washington Horse Racing Commission as clocker/identifier and filled numerous other racing official positions with the WHRC as well. Named to the Board of Stewards at Emerald Downs in 1999, presiding steward 2005 through 2009 race meets.

In September of 2009 accepted the Deputy Secretary position with the commission and was named Executive Secretary in March of 2013, and filled that position until January of 2023 at which time he was named Commissioner.
